(5) the objection must state the exact grounds on which the objection is based; and

(6) if you wish to present the Court with oral argument on your objection at the hearing,

the objection must indicate your intention to appear at the hearing and make such oral argument. Failure to request oral argument in your objection may be

deemed by the Court to be a waiver of the right to oral argument.

Failure to comply with the above time limitations or failure to file a proper written
