O R D E R

NOW on this 16<sup>th</sup> day of December, 1985, the Court having reviewed the Application for Instructions submitted by Gerald Grimes, Insurance Commissioner, State of Oklahoma, and duly appointed and acting Receiver of and for Great Plains Casualty Corporation (hereinafter referred to as the Company), instructs and orders as follows:

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Receiver cancel all existing policies of insurance issued by the Company, with ten (10) days written notice of cancellation to be mailed by non-registered mail to each policyholder, on a form indential to the form attached to the Application of the Receiver filed herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any policy provision or statutory requirement that said notice of cancellation be given to the policyholder by registered mail, is hereby waived for all policies cancelled by the Company on or after the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Receiver, after cancellation of said policies, shall determine the amount of unearned premium due policyholders, and submit to this court, within one hundred twenty (120) days of cancellation, for the Court's review and approval, a procedure for the payment to policyholders of said unearned premiums.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that workers and medical providers with claims against the Company, arising under Workers' Compensation policies issued by the Company, may prosecute said claims through the Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Court and the Appellate Courts of Oklahoma and said Courts may enter awards and judgements against the Company on behalf of said workers and medical providers; that the Preliminary Injunction issued by this Court on November 6, 1985, staying the commencement and prosecution of actions against the Company and the obtaining of judgements thereby, shall not apply to the prosecution of claims by workers and medical providers through the Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Court and the Appellate Courts of Oklahoma.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Receiver shall continue to pay valid claims, and defend actions filed against the Company in the Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Court and Appellate Courts of Oklahoma, and pay the judgements and awards made by said Courts against the Company.
