RECEIVER'S FIRST REPORT ON CLAIMS EVALUATION AND REQUEST FOR CONFIRMATION OF RECEIVER'S RECOMMENDATION

John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner, as Receiver of New Crown Management Corporation, Inc., d/b/a Crown Hill Cemetery ("Crown Hill") and pursuant to the Order entered February 18, 2016 respectfully submits to this Court the Receiver's First Report on Claims Evaluation and Request for Confirmation of Receiver's Recommendation, and in support thereof, would show the Court as follow:

BACKGROUND

- 1. By Order dated February 18, 2016 John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma was appointed as Receiver of Crown Hill and placed Crown Hill into Receivership and Liquidation.
- 2. The Liquidation Order required the Receiver to notice all persons holding claims against Crown Hill to file proofs of claims. Such Notice is also mandated by Title 36, § 1930. The August 25, 2016 Order approved the form of the notice and proof of claims. The

Receiver took all reasonable efforts to determine the identity of all persons who may have claims against Crown Hill and to provide them with notice to allow them the opportunity to file a claim before the October 15, 2016 claims bar date.

- 3. The Receiver distributed 275 notice of proof of claim process and the availability of the proof of claim was published on August 25, 2016 and posted on the Oklahoma Receivership Office website http://www.okaro.org.
- 4. On October 18, 2016, the Receiver filed the Receiver's Report of Filed Claims. The Receiver's report stated that 32 proof of claims have been filed with the Receiver. Since that date the following is the list of untimely filed proof of claims:

- 5. The Receiver informs the Court that 9 Class 6 claims are ready for adjudication at this time. Pursuant to 36 O.S. § 1927.1, Class 6 is "Claims of any person, including claims of state or local governments, except those specifically classified elsewhere in this section."
- 6. There remain a total of 25 un-adjudicated claims consisting of 23 timely filed claims and 2 late filed claims. All claims appear to be claims for Class 6 services. Additional information has been requested from claimants. As claims become ready for adjudication, the Receiver will file additional reports.

EXPLANATION OF RECEIVER'S RECOMMENDATION

7. Attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is a report detailing the Receiver's recommendation. The table below is a summary of the Receiver's recommendations with respect to the claims that are ready for adjudication:

- 8. The Receiver has analyzed the claims reflected on Exhibit 1 and recommends that each of the claims be classified as a Class 6 claim for purposes of 36 OKLA. STAT. § 1927.1.
- 9. The "Amount Claimed" column on Exhibit 1 reflects the amount that the claimant sought through the particular claim. The "Amount Allowed" column sets forth the amount the Receiver recommends that the Court allow as to that particular claim.
- 10. The Proof of Claim form filed by each claimant contains the following language in bold type: "If you have a change of address, you are required to inform the receiver of the new address in order to receive any payment that might be due." To the extend any Notice of this proceeding is returned undeliverable, the Receiver asks the Court to find that the due process rights of the claimant have not been impaired and to order the denial of their claim without further attempts to give actual notice.
- 11. In compliance with the due process required by 36 O.S. § 1918, the Receiver asks the court to set a hearing on the claims and establish a date certain for filing the objection to the Receiver's recommendation.

WHEREFORE, the Receiver prays that this Court enter an Order for the following: 1) order that notice of opportunity to object and be heard on the claims on the Exhibit be given by the Receiver; 2) establish a date for filing an objection to the recommendation of the Receiver; 3) establish a date for hearing the Receiver's recommendation to the court and any objections thereto; 4) upon hearing any objections thereto, enter an order approving the Receiver's Report; and 5) such other relief as the Court deems appropriate.
