## ORDER DETERMINING CLAIMS, APPROVING RECEIVER'S THIRD REPORT ON CLAIMS

Defendant.

On this 16th day of May, 2013, there came on for hearing the Receiver's Third Report on Claims Evaluation and Request for Confirmation of Receiver's Recommendations filed with the Court on February 5, 2013 ("Receiver's Third Report"). The Receiver appeared through his counsel, Jon M. Payne of the law firm of Newton, O'Connor, Turner & Ketchum, P.C. No one appeared at the hearing in opposition to the Receiver's Third Report.

The Court, for good cause shown, and being fully advised, finds and concludes as follows:

- The Receiver made good faith and sufficient efforts to determine the identity of 1. all persons who may have claims against Pegasus Insurance Company, Inc. ("Pegasus") and mailed approximately 6,400 Proof of Claim packets to such potential claimants, including notice of the opportunity to file a claim before the February 8, 2011 claims bar date.
  - A total of 147 timely proofs of claims were submitted to the Receiver. 2.
- On February 8, 2012, the Receiver filed the Receiver's First Report on Claims, 3. Evaluation and Request for Confirmation of Receiver's Recommendations ("Receiver's First Report"). The Receiver's First Report presented the Receiver's recommendations as to 79

claims. After a hearing, the Court approved the Receiver's First Report and adjudicated those 79 claims in accordance with the Receiver's recommendations.

- 4. On August 8, 2012, the Receiver filed the Receiver's Second Report on Claims Evaluation and Request for Confirmation of Receiver's Recommendations ("Receiver's Second Report"). The Receiver's Second Report presented the Receiver's recommendations as to 17 additional claims. After a hearing, the Court approved the Receiver's Second Report and adjudicated those 17 claims in accordance with the Receiver's recommendations.
- 5. The Receiver's Third Report presented the Receiver's recommendations as to 10 additional claims, including four (4) Class 3 claims and six (6) Class 6 claims.
- 6. On February 7, 2013, the Court issued its Order Establishing Deadlines Relating to Receiver's Third Report on Claims Evaluation and Setting Hearing Date for Receiver's Third Report ("February 7, 2013 Order").
- 7. The February 7, 2013 Order set a deadline of March 15, 2013, for claimants to file an objection to the Receiver's recommendations, approved the form of the notice ("Notice") to be given to claimants, and set the Receiver's Third Report for hearing on May 16, 2013.
- 8. On February 7, 2013, the Receiver mailed the written, Court-approved Notice to each of the claimants whose claims are addressed in the Receiver's Third Report. The Notice stated the March 15, 2013 deadline for filing objections to recommendations in the Receiver's Third Report, as well as the date, time and place of the Court's hearing on the Receiver's Third Report. Additionally, the Notice contained the specific recommendations of the Receiver as to the claim of the claimant to whom the Notice was sent.
- 9. The March 15, 2013 deadline for filing an objection to the Receiver's Third Report has passed and no objections to the Receiver's Third Report were filed.

- 10. The Receiver's recommendations as to the 10 claims addressed in the Receiver's Third Report, as detailed in Exhibits 1, 2 and 3 of the Receiver's Third Report, are supported by the law and the facts and the Receiver's recommendations should be approved by this Court.
- 11. The disallowance of any timely-filed proof of claim does not alter the statutory obligation, if any, of the Oklahoma Property & Casualty Insurance Guaranty Association or other applicable state guaranty fund, to provide indemnity and defense of a "covered claim" as defined by the Oklahoma Property & Casualty Insurance Guaranty Association Act, 36 O.S. § 2004(7), or other applicable statute.
- 12. There is no just reason to delay the entry of a final, appealable Judgment as to the matters hereby adjudicated. Good cause exists to enter this order as a final appealable Order, pursuant to 12 O.S. § 994(A).
- 13. This is a final and appealable order as to the matters addressed herein for purposes of 36 O.S. § 1902(H) and in accordance with 36 O.S. § 1918(D).
- 14. Pursuant to the Receiver's request, the Receiver shall identify the claim on the attached Exhibits by reference to the claim number and shall redact from any Exhibits the names of the claimants. When no amount or \$0.00 is stated in the "Amount Allowed" column on an attached Exhibit with respect to a claim, the claim is disallowed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Receiver's Third Report is hereby APPROVED and the recommendations contained therein, as set forth in the attached Exhibits 1 through 3 of the Receiver's Third Report, are hereby ACCEPTED and APPROVED in their entirety.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that each of the claims identified on Exhibit 1 attached to this Order is properly classified as a Class 6 claim under 36

O.S. § 1927.1 and is disallowed, in accordance with the Receiver's recommendations, as reflected on Exhibit 1 attached to this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that each of the claims identified on Exhibit 2 attached to this Order is properly classified as an untimely Class 3 claim under 36 O.S. § 1927.1 and is disallowed, in accordance with the Receiver's recommendations, as reflected on Exhibit 2 attached to this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that each of the claims identified on Exhibit 3 attached to this Order, is properly classified as a Class 6 claim under 36 O.S. § 1927.1 and is (a) allowed in accordance with the Receiver's recommendations, as reflected on Exhibit 3 attached to this Order; and (b) found to be untimely and not eligible to share in any distribution of the Estate except as allowed under 36 O.S. § 1930.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that this Order is hereby certified, pursuant to 12 O.S. § 994(A), to be a final, appealable Order and, accordingly, the Court Clerk is hereby directed to file this instrument as a final, appealable Order.
