**ORDER APPROVING RECEIVER'S SEVENTH REPORT ON CLAIMS EVALUATION
AND CONFIRMING RECEIVER'S RECOMMENDATION**

On this 20th day of October, 2017, there came on for consideration the Receiver's Seventh Report on Claims Evaluation and Request for Confirmation of Receiver's Recommendation filed September 6, 2017. The Receiver was present through his Counsel, George M. Emerson, of the law firm of Riggs, Abney, Neal, Turpen, Orbison & Lewis and no one appears in opposition. The Court having examined the Receiver's Report and being fully advised in the premises, finds and orders the following:

1. This Court established April 7, 2014 as the deadline by which creditors must file their proof of claims against the Pride National Insurance Company. The Receiver has provided proper notice of these proceedings and the claims bar date to all known persons or entities known to have a claim against Pride National Insurance Company. Any and all due process interests have been adequately protected by the Receiver's notices.

2. The Receiver's Seventh Report informed the Court that 5 Class 3 claims and 2 Class 6 claims were ready for adjudication. The Receiver's Seventh Report detailed the Receiver's recommendation that each of the 7 claims in the Receiver's Seventh Report be

denied.

3. The Receiver gave proper notice to all claimants listed in the Receiver's Seventh Report of an opportunity to object to the Receiver's recommendation for the denial of the claim by filing a written objection with the Court no later than September 28, 2017.

4. No written objections have been filed nor have any Claimants contacted Counsel or the Receiver's office in opposition to the Receiver's Seventh Report.


5. The Receiver's recommendation of the denial of the 5 Class 3 claims and the 2 Class 6 claims, as described in the Receiver's Seventh Report should be and is hereby approved. All Class 1 – Class 2 Claims shall be paid in full prior to the payment of any Class 3, as provided by 36 O.S. § 1927.1.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Receiver's Seventh Report on Claims Evaluation and Request for Confirmation of Receiver's Recommendation filed September 6, 2017, denying 5 Class 3 claims and 2 Class 6 claims is approved in its entirety.
